Introduction to Imagery Intelligence Workshop - IIIW

Duration: 2 Days **Cost:** \$800 NZD per person

Who Should Attend?

This workshop is designed for individuals wishing to understand the capabilities of using imagery as an intelligence tool. The course has no pre-requisite knowledge requirements and we welcome any delegates who may be considering a career in the military or law enforcement agencies.

Professional Imagery Analysis Course - PIAC (Military)

Duration: 8 Weeks **Cost:** Price on Application. These courses are tailored to individual needs.

Who Should Attend?

Pre-requisite: Delegates should attend the **IIIW**; the **IIIW** is designed to precede the **PIAC**. Individuals are welcome to apply for a course or they can be booked as closed courses allowing the training to be tailored to maximise the value to the sponsor organisation. The **IIIW** can be included at the beginning of the **PIAC** by arrangement.

This more advanced course is designed to develop the skills of professional imagery analysts who need to be aware of, or analyse, imagery for the purpose of intelligence. The course covers training on a variety of imagery sensors from optical and infrared to radar and includes analysis of commercial satellite imagery (CSI) and an understanding of the methods of collection and intelligence report writing. This course is aimed at military and civilian personnel working in government service. This course is run at the unclassified level and deals with generic issues relating to imagery collection and applications including counter terrorism (CT) and support to military operations.

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Law Enforcement Imagery Analysis Course - LEIAC

Duration: 1 Week **Cost:** \$2000 NZD per person

Who Should Attend?

Pre-requisite: No prior training is required for this course.

This course covers training in analysis of imagery from fixed wing or rotary aircraft sensors including optical and infrared. Students are trained in collection of hand-held stereo imagery and digital image processing. Practical applications of imagery in the law enforcement arena include support to counter terrorism, serious crime and missing person searches.

Counter Terrorism Fusion Course - CTFC

Duration: 1 Week **Cost:** \$2000 NZD per person

Who Should Attend?

Pre-requisite: No prior training is required for this course.

With terrorism issues affecting aspects of everyday life around the world, this course examines methods where imagery can be used with other intelligence procedures and software to provide support to counter the terrorist threat. This course is suitable for delegates from organisations such as government or local councils that have a requirement to support planning against such attacks or may be involved in the aftermath of incidents. This course would be useful for Fire Department personnel and other emergency service staff.

Infrared Imagery Analysis Course – IRIAC (Military)

Duration: 1 Week **Cost:** \$2000 NZD per person

Who Should Attend?

Pre-requisite: Delegates should have attended the PIAC or an equivalent course.

This more advanced course is designed to develop the skills of imagery analysts who need to be aware of, or analyse, near and thermal infrared imagery for the purpose of intelligence. This course covers training in analysis of infrared reconnaissance imagery and is aimed at military and civilian personnel working in government service. This course is run at the unclassified level and deals with generic military issues relating to infrared imagery collection and applications including counter terrorism (CT) and support to military operations.

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Unmanned Aerial Vehicle Imagery Analysis Course – UAVIAC (Military)

Duration: 2 Weeks **Cost:** \$4000 NZD per person

Who Should Attend?

Pre-requisite: No prior training is required for this course.

The UAVIAC is designed to develop the skills of imagery analysts who need to be aware of, or analyse Imagery from UAV's for intelligence purposes. This course covers training in analysis of UAV reconnaissance imagery and is aimed at military and civilian personnel working in government service. This course is tailored to specific client requirements depending on the type of UAV in service.
